# 6 Nights | 5 Rounds including Lahinch, Doonbeg & Doonbeg & Enniscrone

This six night, five round package tours the finest courses in Western Ireland, presenting a blend of classic and modern links layouts. It's available from April to October. Lahinch has enjoyed the supreme touch of genius designers of many generations, first Old Tom Morris, followed by Alister Mackenzie and Martin Hawtree. The Dell is a unforgettable par-3 with a tee shot to a hidden green. Greg Norman designed a masterpiece at Doonbeg, taking advantage of the natural setting and majestic beauty the area afforded him. County Louth is a hidden gem dating back to 1892 that features just 50 bunkers, allowing the gorse and hilly terrain that borders the fairways to serve as its natural defense. Carne maintains a natural and beautiful appeal as it sits in splendid isolation along the Wild Atlantic Way, overlooking Blacksod Bay. Continue on to Enniscrone, on the West Coast of Ireland, is situated between the Ox Mountains and Killala Bay and presents not only a fine test of golf but exceptional beauty as well. Deluxe accommodations are provided at Trump Doonbeg and Mount Falcon.

### Sunday, June 11

Play **Lahinch (tbc)**. Originally designed by Old Tom Morris and later modified by Dr. Alister MacKenzie and most recently Martin Hawtree, the course has a vast array of grass covered knolls and sweeping contours. Optimal use is made of the many natural sand dunes, notably at the par three 5th hole, "The Dell", where the green is completely hidden from the tee. Lahinch is the permanent home to the South of Ireland Amateur Championship.

Today play **Doonbeg (tbc)**. The newest addition to Ireland's collection of storied links courses having opened in 2002. The course is located between Lahinch and Ballybunion on the west coast. Originally identified by the Black Watch Regiment as the preferred site for their course in the 1890's, it was overlooked in favor of Lahinch due to superior railroad access. Greg Norman has designed a magnificent links course, carved out of a landscape of grass covered dunes which border the Atlantic Ocean. Each of the holes offers wonderful panoramas of the ocean and the Irish countryside.
